Building an Integrated Decarbonisation Platform

Adani Group is advancing an execution-led transition to a low-carbon economy, focused not only on clean energy generation, but also on building the integrated ecosystem required to decarbonise hard-to-abate sectors.

The portfolio has committed to developing 50 GW of renewable energy capacity by 2030, contributing meaningfully to India's clean energy ambitions. Adani Green Energy is developing the world's largest single-location renewable energy plant (30 GW) at Khavda, Gujarat, demonstrating the portfolio's ability to deliver complex energy infrastructure at an unprecedented scale.

Beyond generation, Adani Group is strengthening the backbone of the energy transition through grid modernisation, high-capacity transmission, and large-scale energy storage, enabling reliable, round-the-clock renewable power for industry and cities alike.

Advancing Net Zero across key sectors

All Adani portfolio companies are aligned with India's Net Zero ambition, with five businesses (Adani Ports and SEZ, Adani Green Energy (AGEL), Adani Energy Solutions (AESL), Ambuja Cements, and ACC) committed to achieving Net Zero by 2050 or earlier. These commitments span emissions-intensive sectors such as ports, cement, and power transmission, reflecting transition pathways grounded in operational realities rather than aspiration alone.



Green hydrogen: from vision to execution

To address the "last mile" of decarbonisation, Adani Group is building one of the world's most ambitious integrated green hydrogen ecosystems, with a long-term ambition of producing 1 million tonnes annually, supported by in-house solar, wind, and electrolyser manufacturing.

The portfolio has moved beyond concept to execution, commissioning India's first off-grid green hydrogen pilot and initiating real-world applications across mining, thermal power, and city gas distribution. These pilots are designed to validate scalable decarbonisation pathways where existing approaches alone are not sufficient.

Environmental stewardship: circularity, water, and nature at scale

Across the portfolio, Adani Group is embedding circular resource management into operations, improving efficiency while reducing environmental impact. Multiple businesses, including AGEL, AESL, Ambuja Cements, and ACC, are certified water-positive for their operations. In FY25, 83% of total water withdrawal across the portfolio was sourced from non-competing sources, reflecting disciplined water stewardship.

Circularity is a core operational principle. Over 99% of waste generated across the Adani Portfolio is diverted from landfill, with several businesses achieving zero waste to landfill and single-use plastic-free certifications across operational sites. As part of its commitment to ecosystem restoration, Adani Group has pledged to grow 100 million trees by 2030 under the World Economic Forum's 1t.org initiative, with over 40 million trees already planted across businesses by FY25, supporting biodiversity, carbon sequestration, and community resilience.

Creating shared value for people and communities.

Nurturing our Workforce

Adani's people are central to its long-term success. The portfolio is committed to fostering a fair, inclusive, and empowering workplace, supported by strong human rights policies, continuous capability building, and a portfolio-wide focus on health, safety, and well-being. Safety systems are reinforced through common standards, digital platforms, and leadership accountability across businesses.

Driving Inclusive Growth

Through the Adani Foundation, the portfolio advances inclusive development across education, healthcare, livelihoods, and climate resilience. Community initiatives have reached over 9.6 million people across more than 7,000 villages in 22 states, reinforcing the belief that infrastructure-led growth must translate into broad-based social progress.



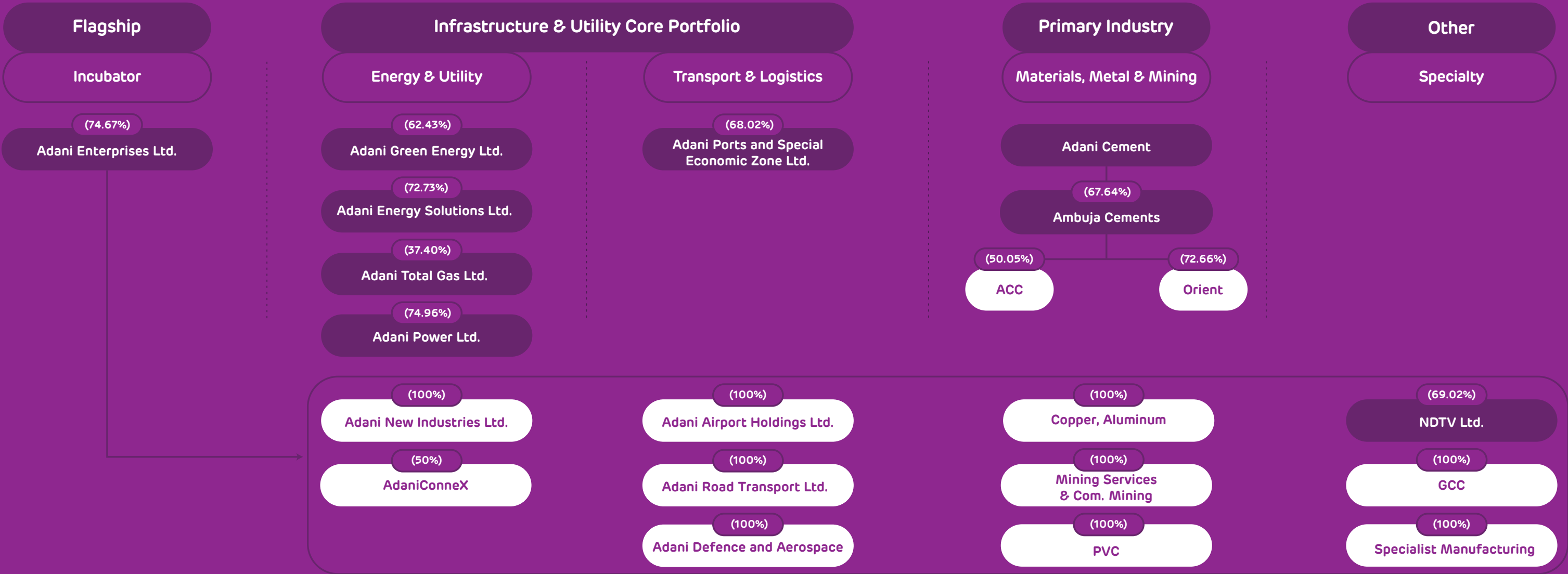
Strong governance underpins Adani's ESG approach. ESG oversight is anchored at the highest level, with each listed company having a Board-level Corporate Responsibility Committee composed entirely of independent directors, responsible for guiding ESG strategy and oversight. ESG considerations are integrated into enterprise risk management, strategic planning, and performance review processes.

The portfolio follows robust codes of conduct, anti-bribery and anti-corruption policies, and structured grievance redressal mechanisms for stakeholders. 100% of board members across the portfolio are trained on ESG, reinforcing informed decision-making and accountability.

Transparency remains a cornerstone of governance. Each listed entity publishes an Integrated Annual Report aligned with leading global and national frameworks, including <IR>, GRI, IFRS, and SEBI-BRSR, ensuring consistent, credible, and comparable disclosures.

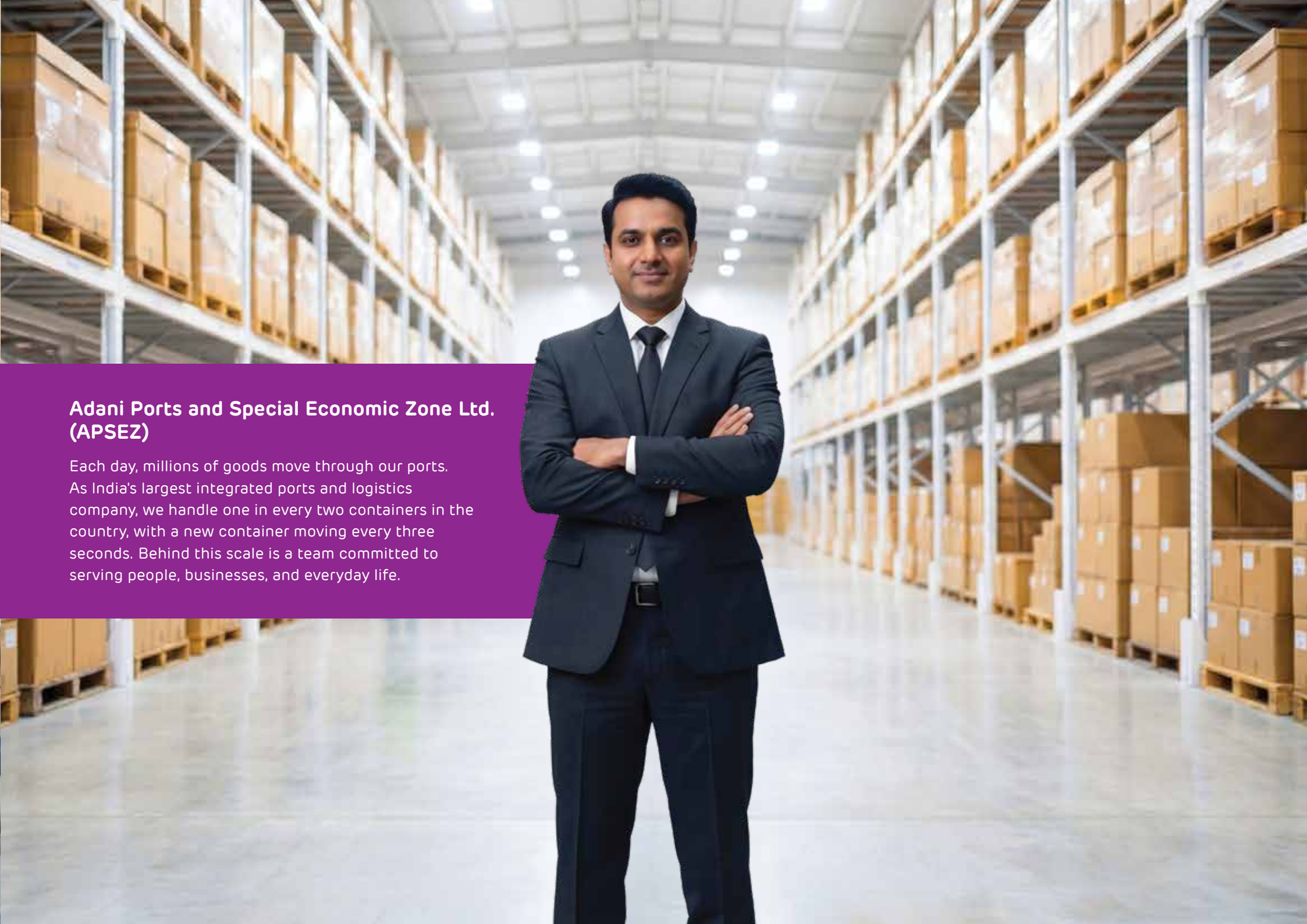

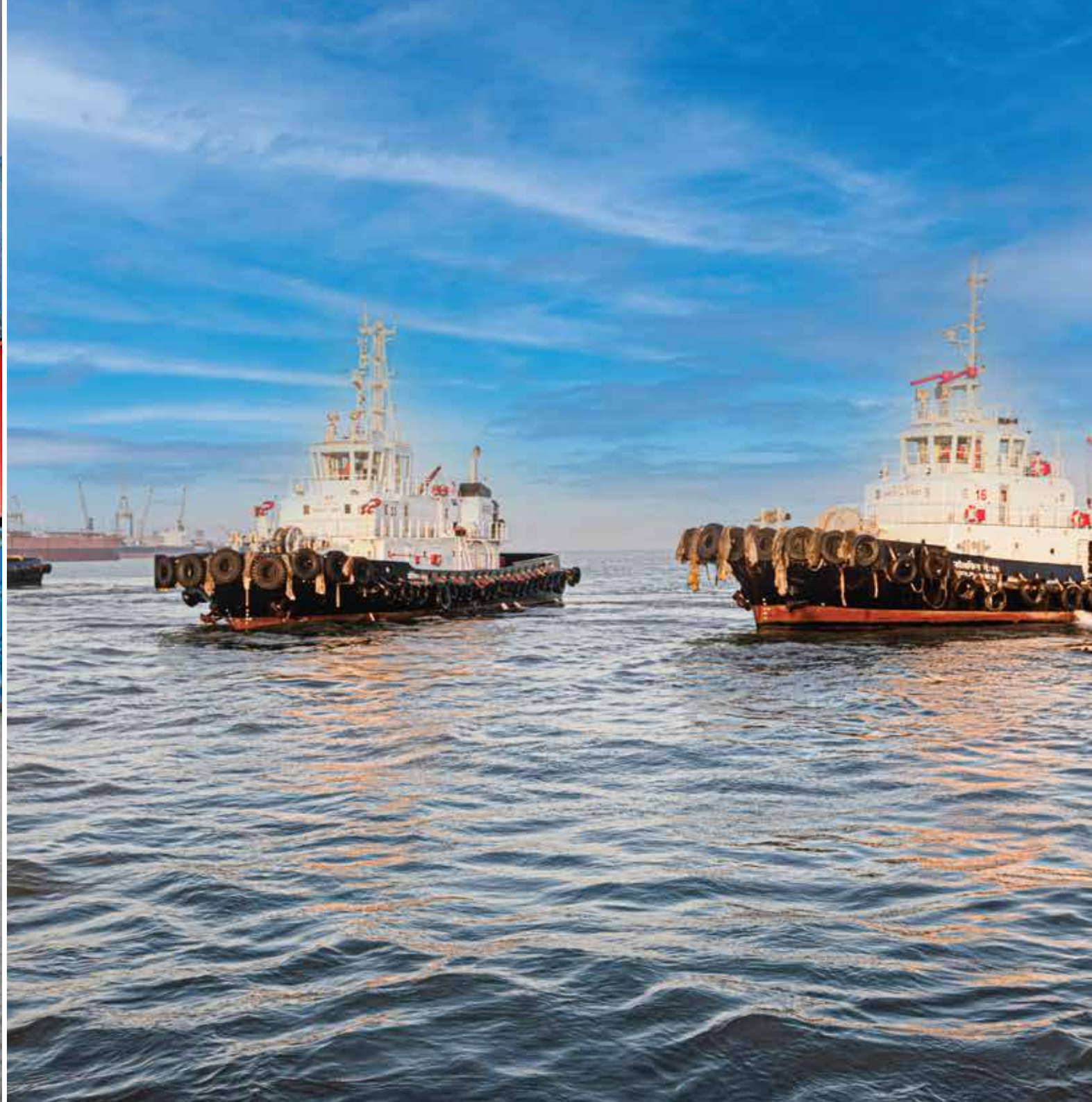

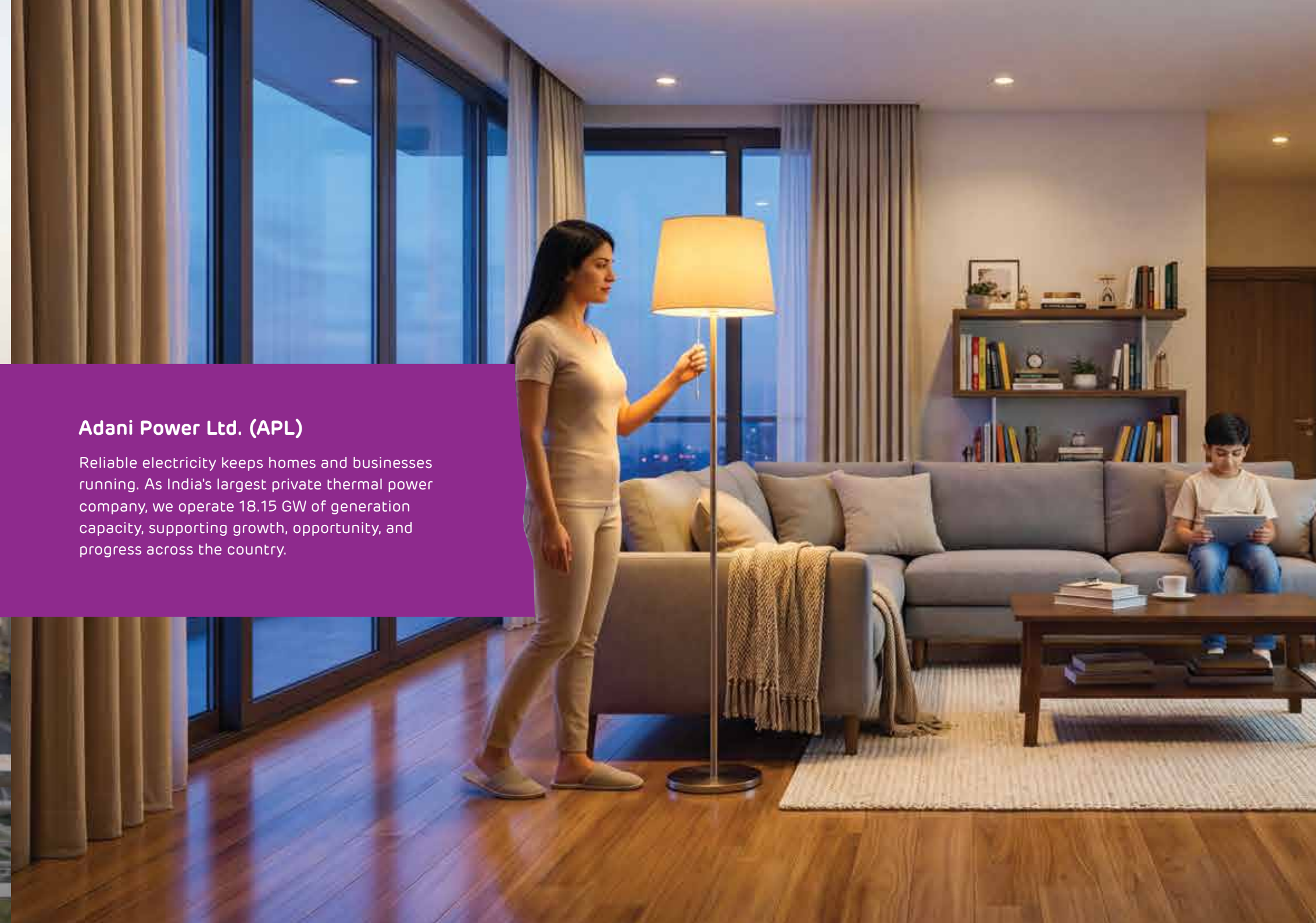

Adani's thermal power portfolio comprises 18.11 GW operating capacity across 13 plants at Mundra (Gujarat), Tiroda, Butibori, and Dahanu (Maharashtra), Kawai (Rajasthan), Udupi (Karnataka), Raipur, Raigarh, and Korba (Chhattisgarh), Mutiara (Tamil Nadu), Mahan (Madhya Pradesh), Godda (Jharkhand), and Singrauli (Madhya Pradesh). It also operates a 40 MW solar power plant at Bitta in Gujarat.

Registering the world's first supercritical thermal power project under the Clean Development Mechanism (CDM) of the Kyoto Protocol and also set up Asia's first Ultra-Supercritical Plant, it is just the beginning of the continuing journey of progress.

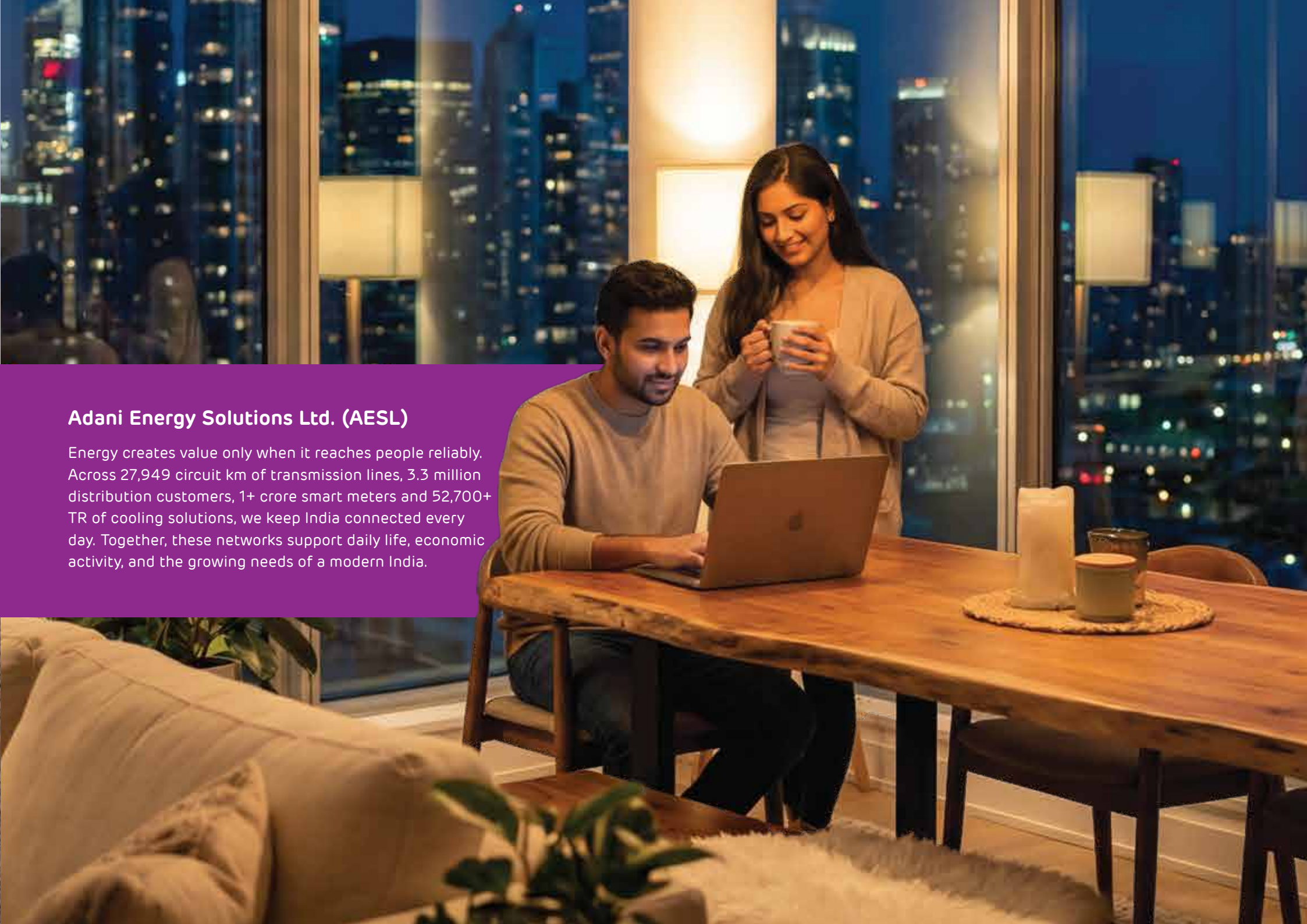

AESL is India's leading energy solutions company in the areas of Transmission, Distribution, Smart Metering, and District Cooling. AESL is India's largest private sector power transmission company with 27,949 ckm of transmission lines and 1,23,175 MVA of transformation capacity. We have invested in the latest technologies, resulting in the highest network availability of over 99.7%, which corresponds to the best global standards. AESL is leading the charge by developing 12 GW of renewable power evacuation infrastructure within the world's largest 30 GW renewable energy project in Khavda, Gujarat. This monumental endeavour isn't just transforming India's renewable sector but is also making waves on a global scale.

In distribution, AESL is India's largest private sector distributor, serving over 3.3 million consumers in metropolitan Mumbai and the industrial hub of Mundra SEZ with 99.99% reliability. The company is on track to meet 60% of the Mumbai region's power demand through renewable power by FY27, up from 35% currently. AESL has been rated as the nation's top power distribution utility by Government of India (through McKinsey and PFC) thrice in a row. AESL is also India's leading smart metering integrator with over 1 cr installed meters and an order book of 2.3 cr meters across five states. In district cooling, the company offers Cooling-as-a-Service to mixed-use real estate projects and is executing 52,700 TR (tons of refrigeration) of cooling projects. AESL is not just reshaping India's energy landscape but also setting new benchmarks for global sustainability and reliability.

AESL also offers bulk electricity uses in the Commercial & Industrial (C&I) sector with customised energy solutions, helping them achieve their sustainability goals in a cost-efficient manner.

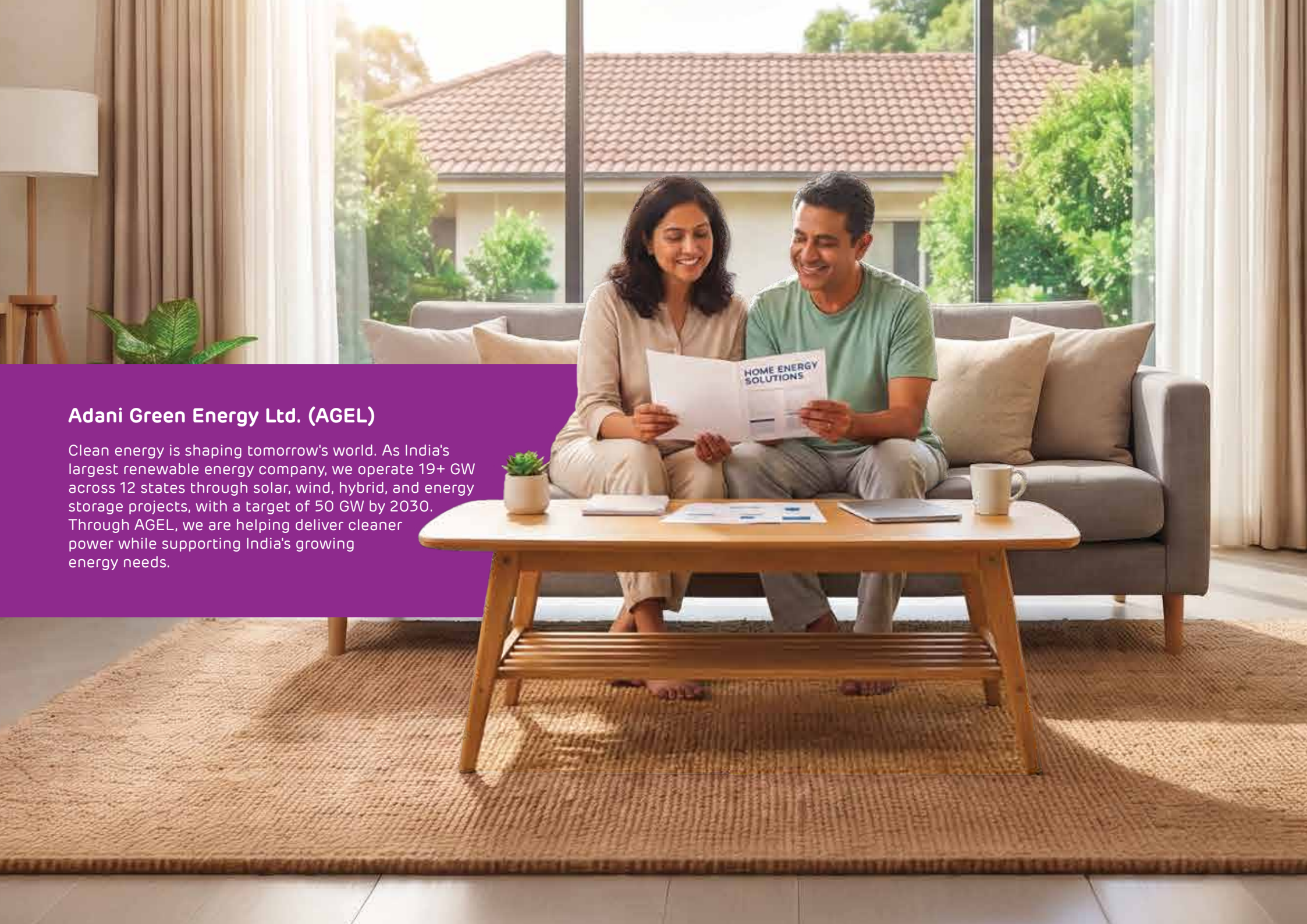

The company is developing the world's largest renewable energy plant of 30 GW at Khavda, Gujarat, spread across 538 sq km, an area five times the size of Paris. The plant will generate over 87 billion units of clean electricity, capable of powering over 17 million households.

Solar Energy

In 2016, we were the fastest off the starting blocks, having set up the largest solar power plant in the world at Kamuthi, Tamil Nadu. Adani Green Energy's pursuit of growing our renewable portfolio has been second to none. We are driving one of the fastest-ever decarbonisation programmes, given our existing footprints and robust pipeline.

Majority of our operational portfolio consists of solar energy capacity. As a testimony to our commitment, our renewable energy operating capacity since FY19 has outpaced the renewable capacity growth in India.

Wind Energy

Wind energy offers a more consistent renewable power output, driven by a higher Capacity Utilisation Factor (CUF). To advance project development, we conduct continuous, data-led assessments across the country to identify and validate high-potential wind resources.

Adani Green Energy has deployed an extensive network of wind measurement masts across resource-rich locations in India, enabling accurate site-specific validation and precise micrositing. This is complemented by high-efficiency turbines, farm-level aggregation strategies, advanced resource assessment algorithms, and optimised last-mile connectivity, collectively enhancing operational efficiency and maximising energy yield across our wind portfolio.

Solar-Wind Hybrid Energy

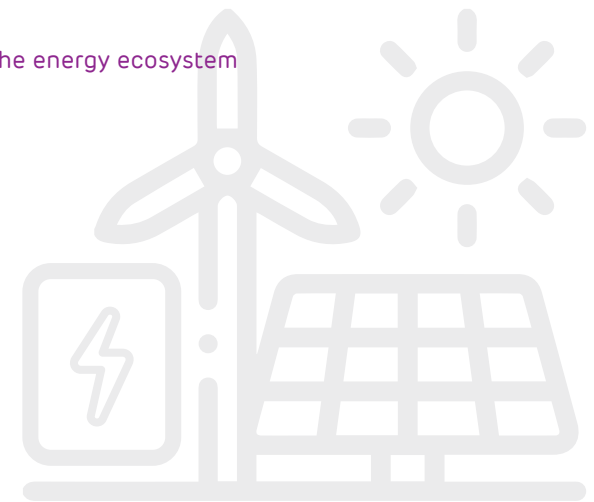
Variability in solar and wind generation has emerged as a concern in the large-scale adoption of renewables since they contribute a major share of the energy mix. The hybridisation of wind and solar plants reduces the variability due to the complementary nature of their generation profiles; solar generation is higher during the day, while wind generation can be higher at night.

Solar-wind hybrid projects deliver significantly higher capacity utilisation, effectively mitigating intermittency challenges. They also benefit from inherent cost efficiencies through the shared use of transmission infrastructure and land. AGEL's approach to identifying resource-rich sites for hybrid energy, along with proactive transmission planning, aligned with deep resource and generation insights, has enabled it to establish the country's largest hybrid energy portfolio.

Adani Green Energy has operationalised India's first and the world's largest solar-wind hybrid cluster at Jaisalmer, Rajasthan. Now, steadfast in building the world's largest renewable energy plant (solar, wind, solar-wind hybrid, and battery energy storage) at Khavda, Gujarat with a target operational capacity of 30 GW by 2029.

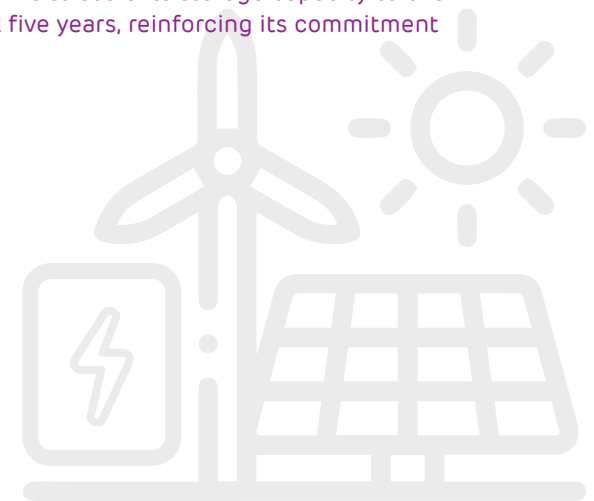
Hydro Pumped Storage Project (PSP)

India's green power revolution is underway at an accelerated pace. This necessitates developing utility-scale storage projects in a speedy and cost-effective manner to aid the base-load requirements. Hydro Pumped Storage, a proven technology, emerges as a possible solution. During periods of ample sunlight and wind, water is pumped to higher-elevation reservoirs. Conversely, when solar or wind power diminishes, water is released to lower reservoirs, effectively filling gaps during peak demand and generating required electricity.

Adani Green Energy's first Hydro Pumped Storage Project (PSP) construction of 500 MW at Chitravathi, Andhra Pradesh, is progressing at an accelerated pace. AGEL has a development pipeline of 5+ GW of Hydro Pumped Storage Projects capacity by 2030, across various states.

Battery Energy Storage (BESS)

BESS marks a significant step in Adani Group's clean energy journey, with a landmark 3+ GWh project at Khavda, the world's largest single-location BESS installation outside China. Designed using advanced lithium-ion technology and integrated energy management systems, the project enables round-the-clock clean power by storing renewable energy and supplying it during peak demand, helping ease grid pressure, reduce transmission congestion, and improve overall efficiency. This initiative strengthens grid reliability and supports large-scale renewable integration. Building on this, Adani Group aims to scale its storage capacity to over 10 GWh by FY27 and 50 GWh over the next five years, reinforcing its commitment to a resilient, low-carbon energy future.

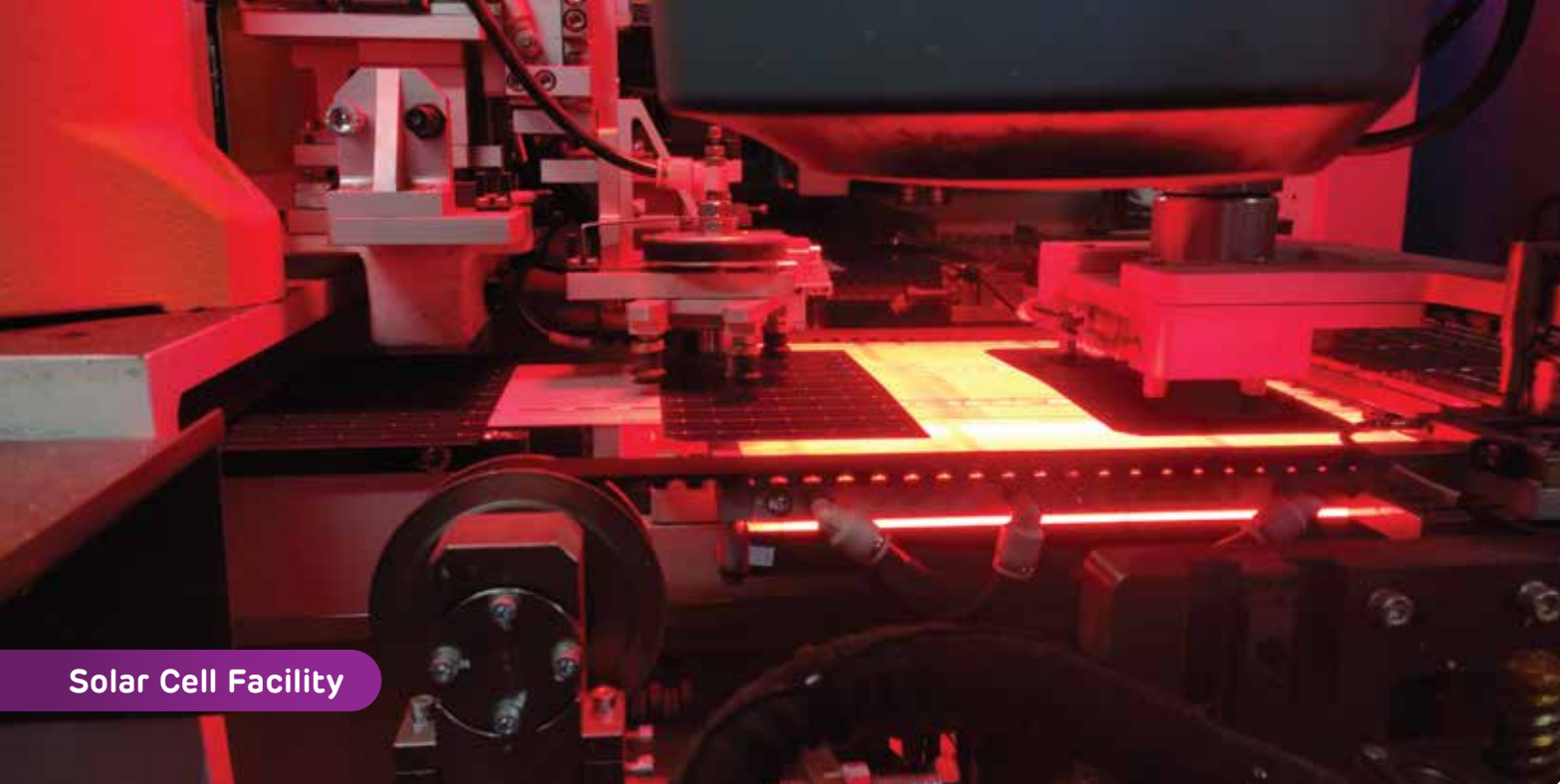
A fully integrated, end-to-end supply chain is central to producing green hydrogen at competitive levelised costs. In-house capabilities across the value chain enable strong cost discipline and enhanced global competitiveness, driving both market expansion and accelerated adoption of green hydrogen and its derivatives.

ANIL's integrated green hydrogen ecosystem, strengthened by Adani Group's robust supply chain control, supports production at significantly lower costs, positioning it as a reliable, scalable, and cost-effective partner for domestic and international markets.

The Green Hydrogen Hub at Mundra, Gujarat, with a planned capacity of 2.1 MMTPA of green hydrogen or equivalent derivatives, reinforces Mundra's emergence as a global clean technology hub. Project rollout is being aligned with market evolution and regulatory developments to ensure long-term viability.

As an early step, ANIL has commissioned India's first off-grid 5 MW green hydrogen pilot plant in Kutch, Gujarat, a significant milestone in the country's clean energy transition. Its electrolyser manufacturing business has also been awarded 300 MW of annual capacity under the SECI Production-Linked Incentive (PLI) scheme, further strengthening the integrated ecosystem.

Adani Solar is India's first and largest vertically integrated solar PV manufacturer with 4 GW cells & modules and 2 GW of ingots & wafers manufacturing capacities. Adani Solar is the only Indian company among the world's top 10 Solar Module Manufacturers in the Global Solar Module Manufacturer Ranking by Wood Mackenzie, a leading global energy and natural resources research and consultancy firm.

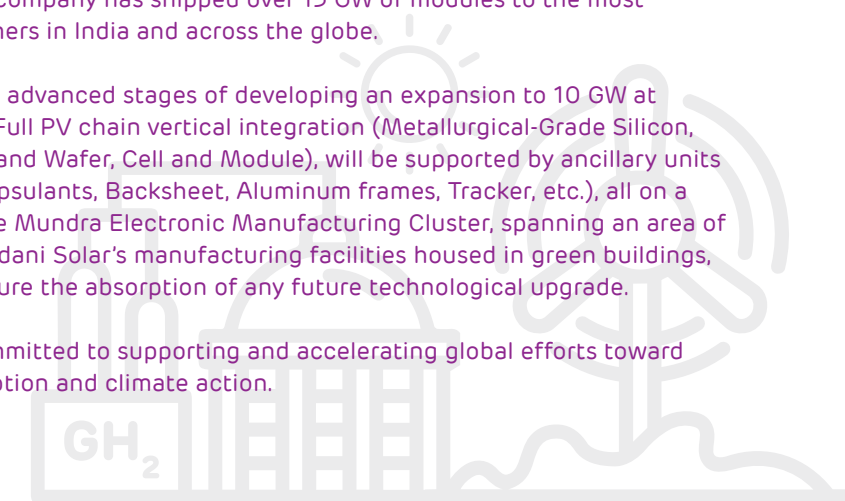
Adani Solar produces Monofacial & Bifacial PV modules in TOPCon & MonoPERC technologies of M10 and G12R footprints with a power class of 535 - 530 Wp, module efficiency of 21.31% - 23.7%. The company continues to evaluate emerging technologies and is committed to offering those too as it expands capacities.

It is the only Indian Solar Panel Manufacturer to be ranked Top Performer for nine years in a row by Kiwa PVEL, an independent test lab in the USA. Adani Solar modules are regarded as the most trustworthy and bankable, and have constantly been ranked in Bloomberg's Tier-1 list of module manufacturers.

Adani Solar's modules have been well accepted in India and in the world too. Since its inception, the company has shipped over 15 GW of modules to the most discerning customers in India and across the globe.

The company is in advanced stages of developing an expansion to 10 GW at Mundra, Gujarat. Full PV chain vertical integration (Metallurgical-Grade Silicon, Polysilicon, Ingot and Wafer, Cell and Module), will be supported by ancillary units (Solar Glass, Encapsulants, Backsheet, Aluminum frames, Tracker, etc.), all on a single campus, the Mundra Electronic Manufacturing Cluster, spanning an area of over 800 acres. Adani Solar's manufacturing facilities housed in green buildings, configured to ensure the absorption of any future technological upgrade.

Adani Solar is committed to supporting and accelerating global efforts toward clean energy adoption and climate action.

Wind Manufacturing

Adani Wind, the wind energy solutions division of Adani New Industries Limited (ANIL), is focused on enabling the global clean energy transition, with an existing product portfolio ranging from 3x MW to 5x MW platforms.

Aligned to bolstering India's energy security, Adani Wind is strengthening the domestic wind manufacturing ecosystem. Adani Wind's end-to-end Wind Turbine Generator (WTG) manufacturing ecosystem is based in Mundra, Gujarat. The company envisions becoming one of the leading global wind Original Equipment Manufacturers (OEM) and is ramping from the current 2.25 GW to a 5 GW per annum manufacturing capacity. With an in-house technology centre established from Rostock, Germany, and technology collaborations with leading academic and research institutes, Adani Wind is focused on developing technologically advanced next-generation wind turbines.

Adani Wind, in collaboration with Wind2Energy (W2E) from Germany, has developed one of the world's most powerful onshore wind turbines of 5.2 MW capacity, a game changer for the global wind energy sector. ANIL's manufacturing expansion is supported by a growing external order book. The company has recently secured 304 MW of orders from independent power producers, including Fourth Partner Energy, First Energy, and Opera Energy, for its 3.3 MW turbine model with a 164 metre rotor. It has also commissioned India's largest operational wind turbine, rated at 5.2 MW, at the world's largest renewable energy plant under development at Khavda, Gujarat. Exports are emerging as a strategic focus, with Made-in-India blades now reaching European markets, incorporating anti-icing technology for colder climates.

The company has an order book of ~1 GW from leading Independent Power Producers (IPPs), covering its 3.3 MW WTG model with 164 metre rotor diameter and 5.0 MW WTG model with 185 metre rotor diameter. Adani Wind's technology development is supported by a technology centre in Rostock, Germany, along with a focused R&D (research & development) team in India. The diversified product portfolio is designed to suit varied wind regimes and is fully certified.

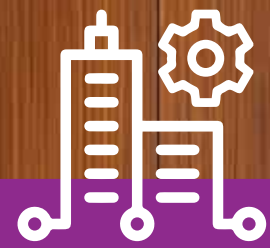

Rugby Run Solar Farm is part of Adani Group's world-leading renewable energy portfolio that is helping progress the global transition to a lower emissions future. Located near the town of Moranbah in central Queensland, Australia, Rugby Run generates 185,000 MWh of power each year. The facility has been consistently among Australia's best-performing solar-energy assets since it was switched on in October 2019.

North Queensland Export Terminal (NQXT)

NQXT is a dedicated deep-water coal export terminal that services and supports Australia's significant resources sector and the central Queensland community of Bowen in which it operates. NQXT has a nameplate capacity of 50 million tonnes per annum and provides strategic export access for thermal and metallurgical coal mines in the Bowen and Galilee mining basins.

The Bowen and Galilee basins are among Australia's most significant resource provinces. NQXT has been operating safely, responsibly, and efficiently within the Port of Abbot Point since 1984. Abbot Point Operations (APO) is contracted to manage the operations and maintenance of the terminal.

The railway was designed to carry 40 million tonnes per annum and has the capacity for further expansion.

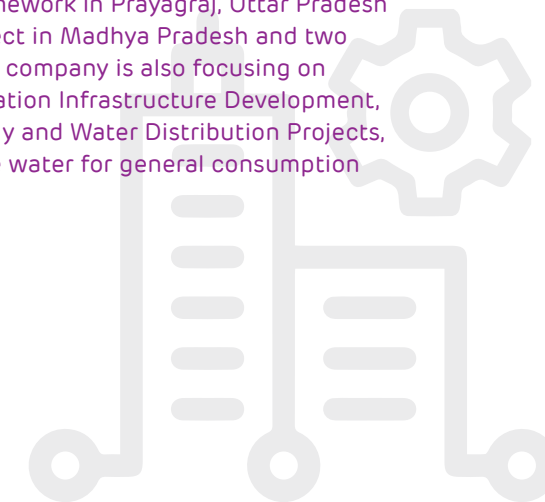

Adani Road Transport Limited currently has 19 road projects spanning over 6,500 lane kilometres across 12 states in India: Chhattisgarh, Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Kerala, Gujarat, West Bengal, Odisha, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Tamil Nadu, and Maharashtra. Of these, 10 projects are in the operational stage, while 9 are currently under construction.

The company has also recently acquired Maharashtra Border Check Post Network Limited, which comprises 24 border check posts across the state.

By combining domain knowledge, secure platforms, and measurable impact, AI Labs is moving the Group from AI pilots to governed, scalable, intelligence-led operations.

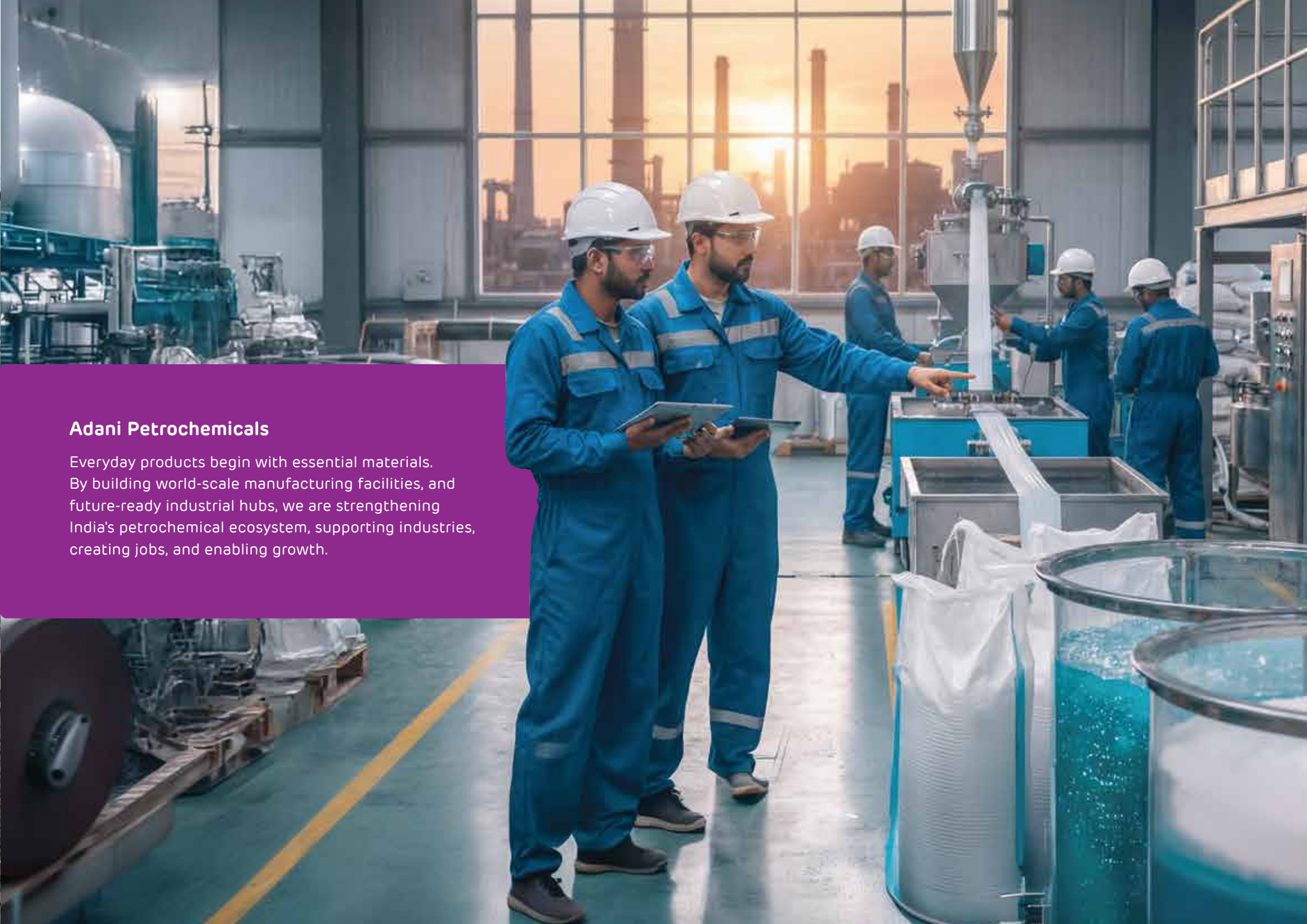

The Group is also exploring opportunities to establish a world-class petrochemical cluster at Mundra, Gujarat, and is evaluating Coal-to-Chemical projects across India's coal-rich states, paving the way for a sustainable, integrated, and globally competitive chemicals and materials ecosystem.

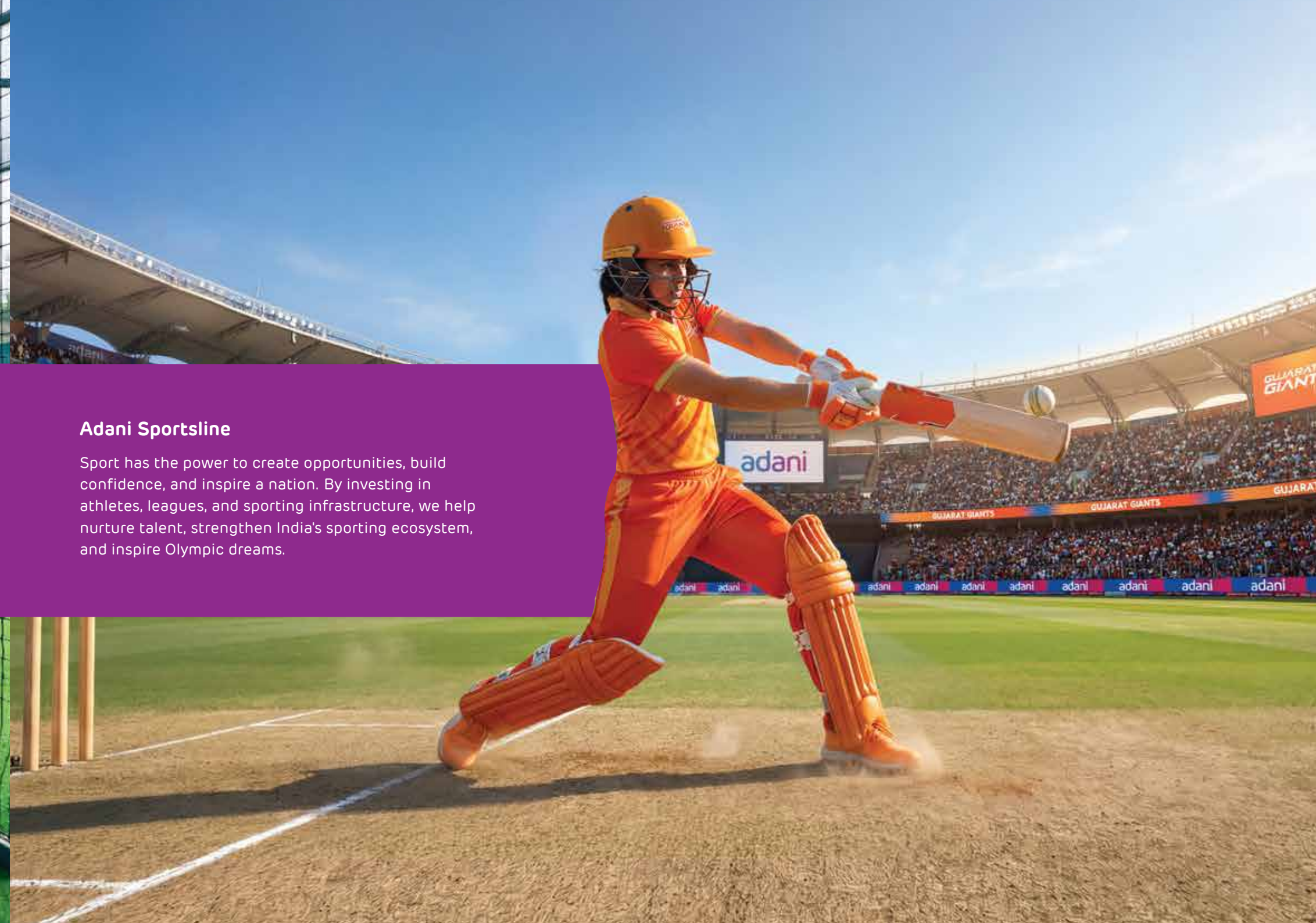

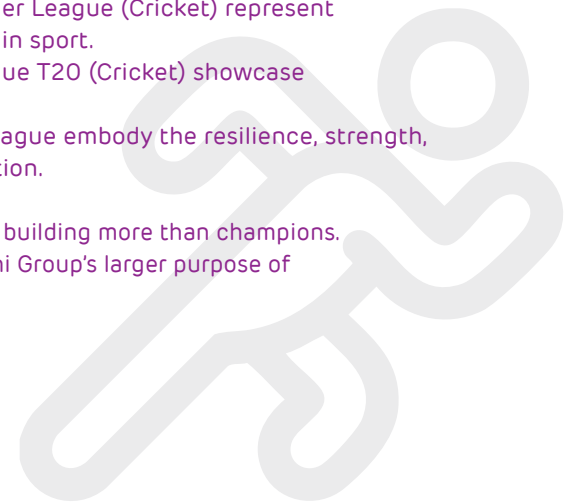

Our growing portfolio of professional sports teams exemplifies this vision:

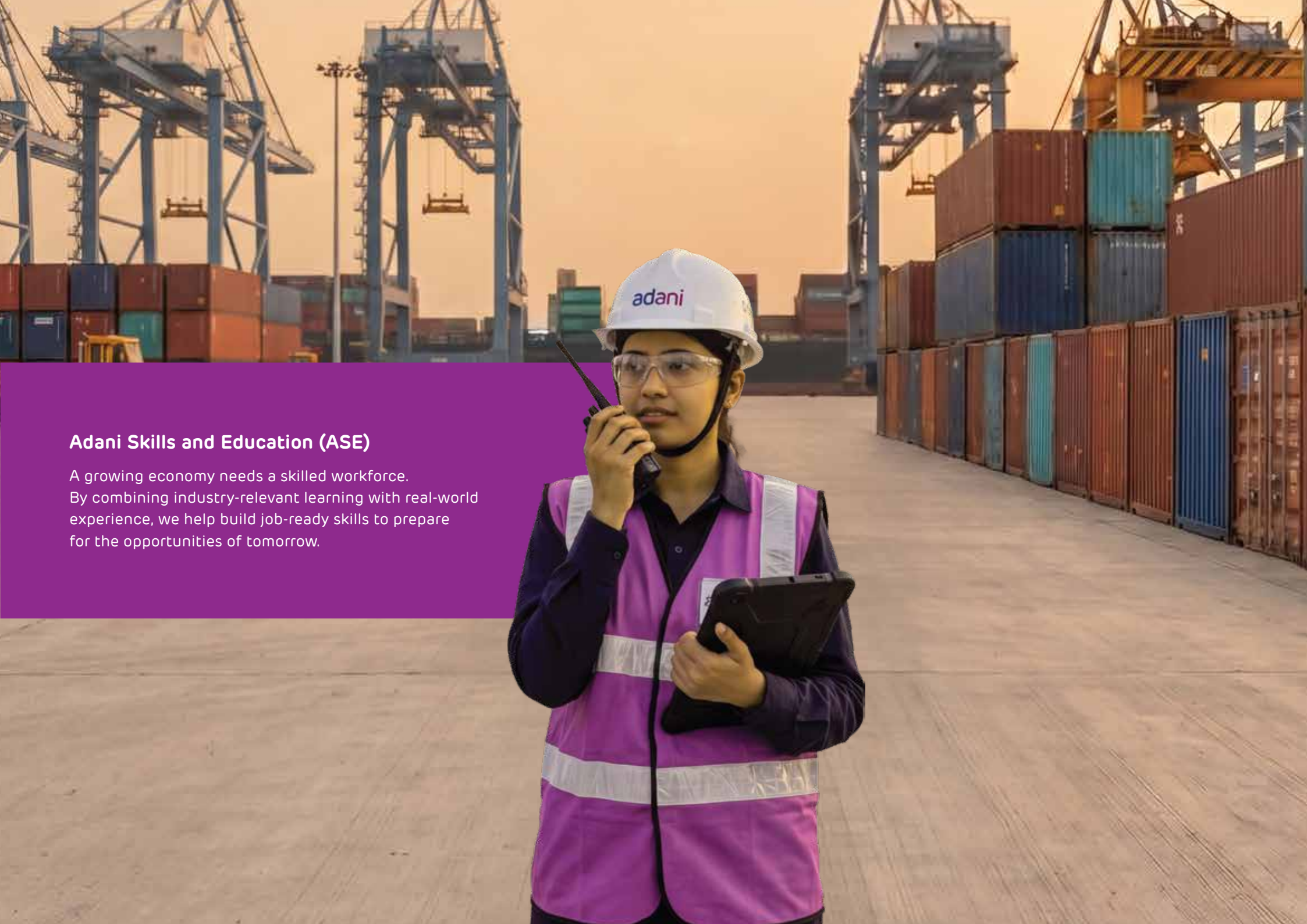

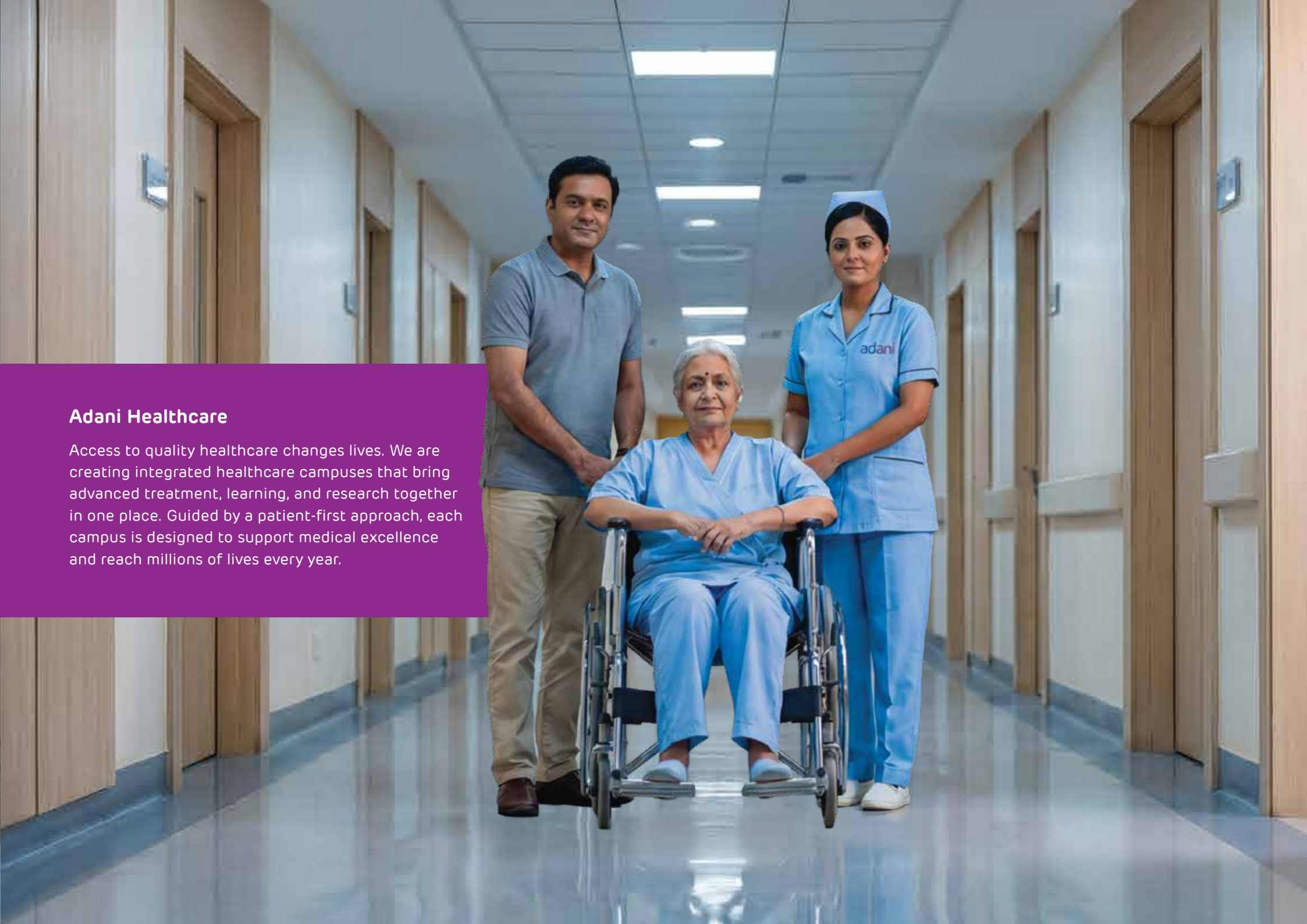

Education

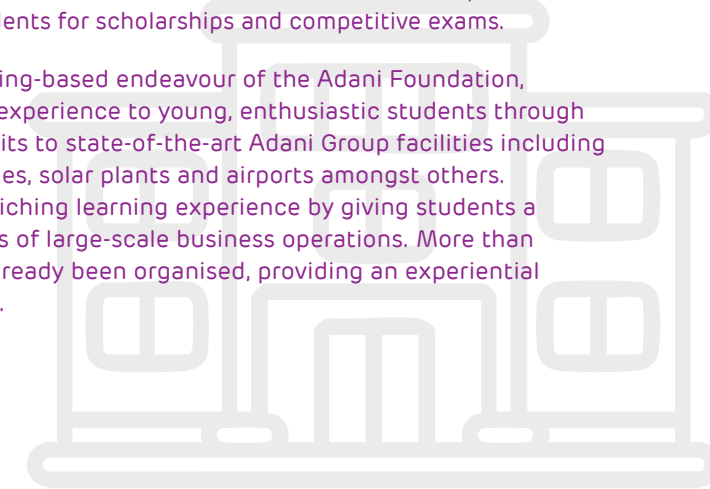
At the Adani Foundation, we empower children with knowledge, critical thinking, and confidence to shape better futures. With 43 schools nationwide, we offer affordable, holistic education through personalised attention, smart technology, and strong partnerships. Our mission is to nurture informed, compassionate individuals rooted in Indian values.

Adani Vidya Mandir Schools (AVMs): Providing free, high-quality education to children from economically disadvantaged backgrounds. Our NABET-accredited 4 AVMs in Ahmedabad (Gujarat), Bhadreswar (Gujarat), Krishnapatnam (Andhra Pradesh) and Surguja (Chhattisgarh) nurture young minds and prepare them for a future of possibilities.

Adani Schools: Located primarily in rural areas, our 39 Adani Schools focus on holistic student development. Through value-based learning, experiential education, and skill-building initiatives, these schools aim to equip students with the knowledge, confidence and moral foundation needed for a happy and successful career.

Project Utthan: Aligned with the National Education Policy 2020, Utthan focuses on improving foundational literacy and numeracy in government primary schools, with a special emphasis on empowering Priya Vidyarthi (progressive learners) ensuring that no student is left behind. It is currently covering more than 1,200 schools, including all 947 Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) schools in Mumbai. Furthermore, Adani Evening Education Centres provide remedial classes to deserving high school students to improve their board exam results and Adani Competitive Coaching Centres prepare students for scholarships and competitive exams.

Project Udaan: A unique learning-based endeavour of the Adani Foundation, Udaan provides an immersive experience to young, enthusiastic students through carefully planned exposure visits to state-of-the-art Adani Group facilities including ports, power plants, oil refineries, solar plants and airports amongst others. The intent is to provide an enriching learning experience by giving students a firsthand feel of the intricacies of large-scale business operations. More than 10,000 exposure visits have already been organised, providing an experiential learning to 5.96 lakh students.





Health & Nutrition

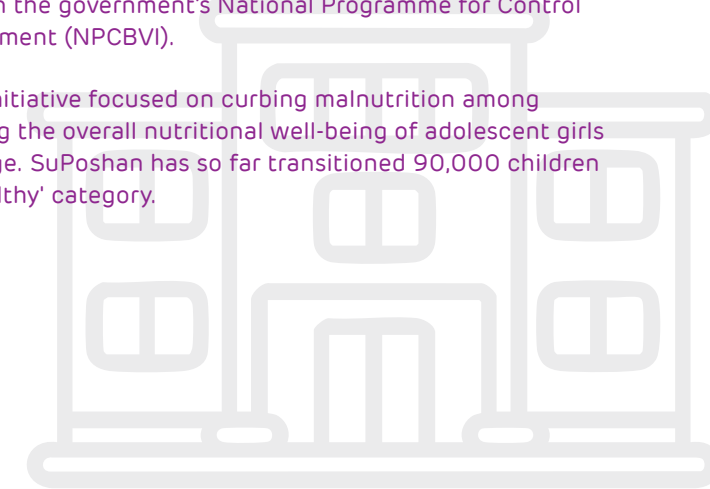
The Adani Foundation is making a meaningful difference by bridging these critical gaps of rural healthcare by reaching the unreached, strengthening local health systems, and building healthier lives from the ground up.

Our Mobile Healthcare Units (MHCUs) and health camps are crucial in reaching elderly people and those with limited mobility, while the rural clinics and hospitals are making quality healthcare accessible to communities that have long been underserved. Our SuPoshan project is fighting malnutrition by training and empowering village-level volunteers, a.k.a. SuPoshan Sanginis, who educate families, monitor health and provide vital nutrition support.

Adani Hospitals: In Gujarat, Adani Hospitals at Bhuj, Mundra, and Kodinar offer essential and specialised care to underserved communities. The recently announced Adani Health City in Mumbai and Ahmedabad will bring world-class medical services to urban communities, while the upcoming Roha hospital (Maharashtra) will support semi-urban and rural populations.

Eye Care Programme: The absence of timely and accurate eye care can severely affect an individual's potential to perform daily tasks, contribute to household income and care for the family. Addressing this concern, our eye care programme helps in early detection and prevention of vision-related problems by providing comprehensive eye care services, including screening, free spectacles and referrals to school students, women, senior citizens and truck drivers at the grassroots level. The programme is aligned with the government's National Programme for Control of Blindness and Visual Impairment (NPCBVI).

SuPoshan: A community-led initiative focused on curbing malnutrition among children under 5 and improving the overall nutritional well-being of adolescent girls and women of reproductive age. SuPoshan has so far transitioned 90,000 children from 'Undernourished' to 'Healthy' category.





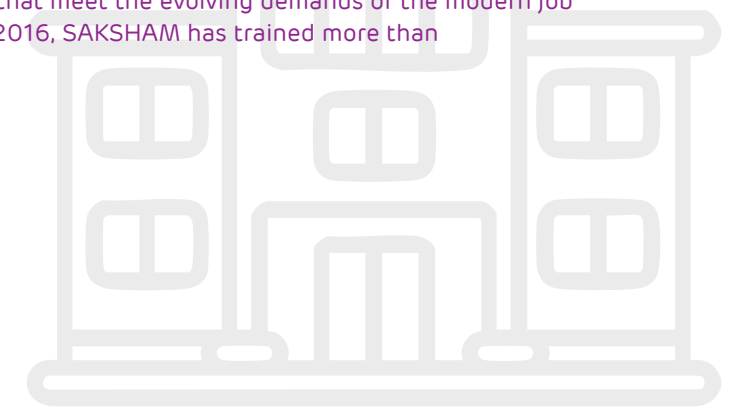
Sustainable Livelihoods

The Adani Foundation harnesses community resources for transformative socio-economic progress. Through our targeted initiatives in on-farm, off-farm, and non-farm sectors, we are driving impactful change to boost, diversify, and sustain incomes. We focus on skilling, natural farming, animal husbandry, dairy development, and the empowerment of women-led enterprises through cutting-edge training, skill development and market access.

Our skilling programme, SAKSHAM, equips the youth with technical and entrepreneurial skills, propelling them toward greater employability and self-reliance. Similarly, our Sathwaro initiative powers art by empowering the country's artisan community.

Women Empowerment: The Foundation has been advocating women's empowerment through skill-based education and training to enable women to be self-reliant. Our interventions (such as Swabhimaan) focus on creating small-scale enterprises, promoting high-value, cash-intensive activities such as mushroom cultivation, dairy farming, tailoring, and even encouraging women to take up farming, thus fostering a composite ecosystem for their economic empowerment. Our manifold approach including skill training (both technical and non-technical), enterprise development, and market facilitation exemplifies how empowering women in rural and urban India can drive social and economic transformation. Through our efforts in education, skilling and entrepreneurship, we have brought a meaningful difference in the lives of over 2 million girls and women across India.

Adani SAKSHAM: The initiative aligns with the government's Skill India Mission by building a self-reliant, job-ready workforce. Through online and offline training across a variety of sectors, we ensure inclusive access. Our tech-driven courses equip youth with future-ready capabilities that meet the evolving demands of the modern job market. Since its inception in 2016, SAKSHAM has trained more than 2 lakh youth.





Agriculture-based Livelihoods: Through our initiatives in drip and lift irrigation, we enable farmers to maximise water use efficiency, resulting in higher crop yields even in water-scarce regions. This increase in productivity has directly translated into improved incomes and greater financial stability for farming households. Beyond irrigation, we actively promote eco-friendly practices such as crop rotation, composting, use of green manures, and biological pest control. By integrating traditional knowledge with modern techniques, the Foundation's efforts have supported a shift towards sustainable agriculture that benefits both the farmer and the ecosystem.

Animal Husbandry and Dairy Development: The Foundation has a multifaceted approach to increase milk yield and thus the incomes. We focus on cattle breed improvement, cattle healthcare, fodder development, while helping practitioners with market linkages. In a nutshell, we focus on creating a robust financial safety net, empowering families with steady incomes, greater resilience, and a pathway out of poverty.

Project Sathwaro: A movement to preserve India's rich artistic heritage by empowering the artisan community. It supports them with dignity, recognition, and sustainable livelihoods, while bridging tradition and modernity. By connecting crafts to contemporary markets, it keeps timeless art relevant and meaningful.





Climate Action

In an era defined by climate uncertainty and environmental challenges, the Adani Foundation's commitment to water conservation, biodiversity preservation, and renewable energy represents a forward-thinking blueprint for sustainable development. These integrated efforts not only address the urgent ecological challenges but also lay the foundation for resilient, thriving communities. Water Conservation and Management: The Adani Foundation has championed a comprehensive, community-led approach to water conservation and management, deepening traditional ponds to enhance storage capacity, installing rainwater harvesting structures to capture seasonal run-off and promoting efficient drip irrigation to maximise every drop. So far, it has created an additional water storage capacity of over 16.5 billion litres across India.

Biodiversity Enhancement: The Foundation's community-driven forest management initiative (Adani Van) integrates advanced technologies for seeding, watering, and monitoring to enable communities to ensure long-term survival and regeneration of green spaces. These new green sanctuaries have become vital corridors for biodiversity, offering refuge to countless species. So far, more than 23 lakh saplings have been planted across India.

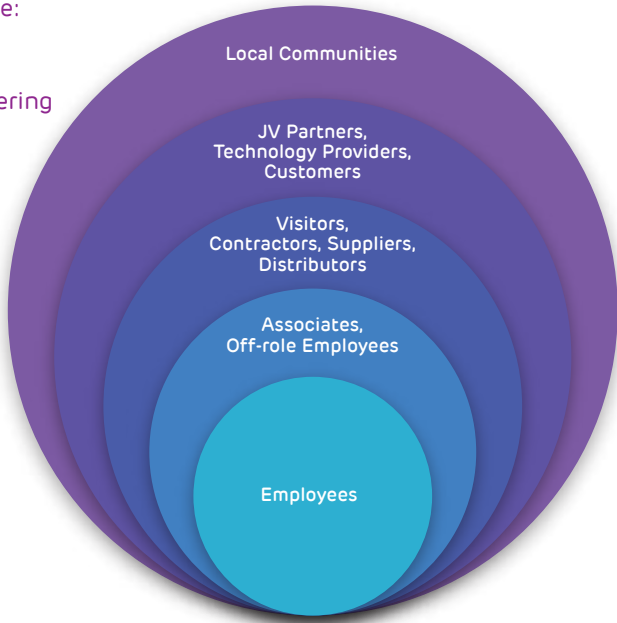

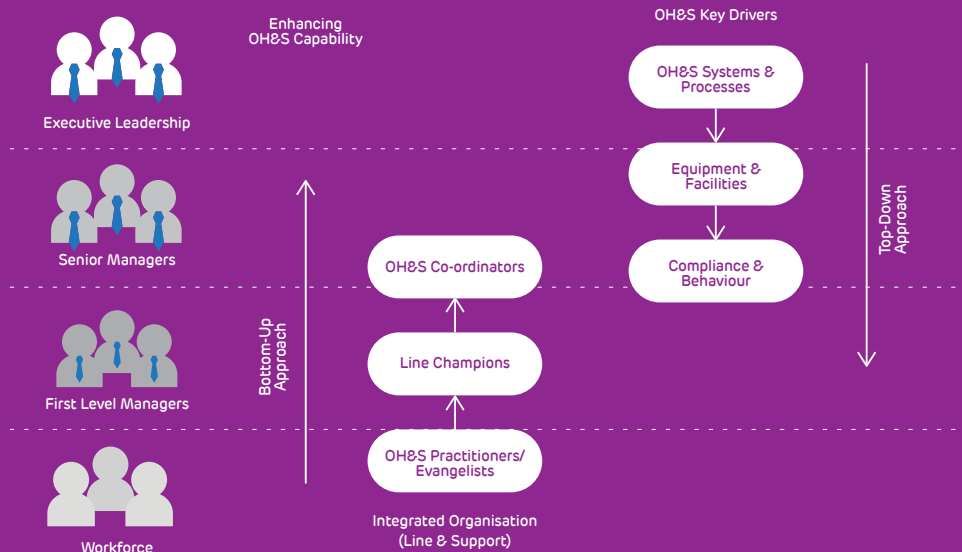
