

In the matter of Annual Tariff Proposal(ATP) for FY2019-20 & FY2020-21 Of the Second Control Period in respect of M/s Air India Air Transport Services Limited (AIATSL) for providing Ground Handling Services at Kolkata, Mumbai, Guwahati, Cochin, Ahmedabad & Calicut International Airports.

- 1) M/s AIATSL is a subsidiary of Air India Limited and provides the services of Ground Handling at various Indian Airports. The Authority vide following orders determined tariff for the following AIATSL airports under “**light Touch Approach**” for the duration of Second Control Period (01.04.2016 to 31.03.2021):



The above mentioned/determined tariff for above airports were on extension till 30.06.2019 vide AERA order No. 48/2018-19. To avoid the regulatory gap, the same tariff are kept under further extension vide AERA Order No. 08/2019-20 dated 26.09.2019 till 31.03.2020 or till determination of tariff whichever is earlier.

- 2) M/s AIATSL submitted their MYTP/ATP for the complete Second Control Period (FY2016-17 to FY2020-21) online on 24th June, 2016. The increase in tariff sought by M/s AIATSL for FY2019-20 and FY2020-21 is 2% year on Year. Further M/s AIATSL vide their letter dated 20.09.2019 submitted the Annual Compliance Statement (ACS) for FY2016-17, FY2017-18 and FY2018-19 for all the major airports. M/s AIATSL has submitted the consolidated Balance Sheet for FY2016-17, FY2017-18 and FY2018-19. M/s AIATSL has submitted the bifurcation of financials (Balance Sheet for FY2016-17, FY2017-18 and FY2018-19) among all its stations where AIATSL is operating.
- 3) M/s AIATSL vide their email dated 24.09.2019 conveyed the concession rate charged by the respective Airport Operator.
- 4) AIATSL has not conducted the stakeholder consultation with the users on the proposed ATP submitted for the complete Second Control Period i.e. FY2016-17, FY2017-18, FY 2018-19, FY2019-20 and FY2020-21.
- 5) The Authority considered the submissions made by AIATSL and issued the Consultation Paper No. 09/2019-20 dated 17th Oct, 2019, wherein, the Authority proposed that the service provider may be allowed with 2% increase in tariff for FY2019-20 and FY2020-21 (year on year) since, the service provider is earning 10% to 11% profit margin (in an average). The observations of the Authority are as follows:


Further, the Authority proposed that the tariff charges for Non-schedule operations provided by the service provider should not exceed the ceiling rates approved by AERA for its scheduled operations for its similar class of aircraft.

- 6) The Authority requested written feedback, comments and suggestions from stakeholders on the above Consultation Paper by 8th Nov, 2019. Only M/s Bhadra International (India) Pvt. Ltd. (Bhadra) commented on the above mentioned CP and requested the Authority for details of "Concession Fee" paid by M/s AIATSL to the Airport Operator. In this regard, it is conveyed that the "Concession Fee" paid to Airport Operator by the Independent Service Provider (ISP) is a matter of agreement between the two parties i.e. Airports Authority of India(AAI) as the Airport Operator and AIATSL as an Independent Service Provider (ISP). However, AERA quantifies the concession fee for the determination of the tariff. AAI is a Public Authority and if M/s Bhadra desires, they may get the information from AAI.
- 7) The Authority vide Public Notice No. 14/2019-20 dated 22.11.2019 displayed in its website the comments of the above mentioned stakeholder.

ORDER

Upon careful consideration of material available on record, as well as submissions made by the stakeholders, the Authority, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 13(1)(a) of the AERA Act, 2008 hereby orders that:

- (i) The Authority in accordance to the provisions of Chapter V of the AERA Guidelines vide its various orders (ref. para 1) above) decided that the tariff will be determined under "**Light Touch Approach**" for the duration of Second Control Period (01.04.2016 to 31.03.2021).
- (ii) The Authority decided to allow M/s AIATSL with an increase of 2% (year on-year) on the existing tariff for FY2019-20 and FY2020-21. The determined tariff is applicable from the date of issue of tariff order to 31.03.2021 and is enclosed as **Annexure-I**.
- (iii) As regards to Non-Scheduled operations of scheduled operators, M/s AIATSL should not exceed the tariff charges as approved by AERA for its scheduled operations for similar class of aircraft.



- (iv) Tariff determined as above will be maximum tariff to be charged excluding statutory taxes, if any. No other charge is to be levied by M/s AIATSL over and above the approved tariff.







The Concession Agreement of CSC for Courier Cargo Services at Mumbai airport is valid only till 31.07.2021.

2. The Authority is in receipt of MYTP/ATP submissions for the 3rd Control Period (FY 2021-26) from some of the Independent Service Providers for Fuel Farm/ITP services. These proposals are currently under scrutiny and Consultation Papers will be issued shortly. Further, MYTP/ATP submissions for the 3rd Control Period (FY 2021-26) in respect of Cargo Handling / Ground Handling services have not been received from many ISPs.

Considering the above, the Authority, expects that the tariff determination process for the aforesaid service providers is likely to take some time. Hence, in the interim, the Authority, has decided that the Independent Services Providers as per above list,



except M/s CSC, Mumbai (at s.no.22 in the list), may be allowed to continue the levy of the existing tariffs, applicable as on 31.03.2021, for a further period of six (06) months w.e.f. 01.04.2021 to 30.09.2021 or till determination of tariff(s) whichever is earlier.


In the case of M/s CSC, Mumbai (at s.no.22 in the list), providing Courier Cargo Services at Mumbai Airport, the Authority observed that their Concession Agreement with the Airport Operator MIAL is valid only till 31.07.2021. In view of the above, the Authority, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 13(1)(a) of the Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India Act, 2008, hereby orders that: -

- (i) The **Independent Service Providers /Airport Operators** providing services relating to Cargo/ Ground Handling/ Supply of Fuel to the Aircrafts at the various Major Airports as listed in table above, are allowed to levy the existing tariff, applicable as on 31.03.2023, for a further period of six (06) months **w.e.f. 01.4.2023 to 30.09.2023**, or, till the determination of regular tariffs by AERA for their respective control periods, whichever is earlier.
- (ii) The Airport Operators shall ensure timely submission of MYTPs/ATPs by the concerned Independent Service Providers operating at their respective 'Major Airports'.
- (iii) The Airport Operator to ensure compliance of this Order.

AERA, vide Order No. 19/2024-25 dated 28th March, 2025, inter-alia, allowed the following Independent Service Providers (ISPs) to levy the then prevailing tariffs, in respect of the services relating to Cargo Facility, Ground Handling & Supply of Fuel to the Aircraft, on interim basis, for a period of 06 (six) months w.e.f. 01.04.2025 to 30.09.2025, or, till the determination of regular tariff for their respective control periods, whichever is earlier:

2. Further, AIASL vide its letter dated 24.09.2025 has conveyed that they are also providing ground handling services at Dehradun, Port Blair & Nagpur Airports, which have recently been considered as major airports. M/s AIASL in its letter dated 24.09.2025 stated that a process of disinvestment of AIASL is under process and same is expected to be completed soon.

Considering the above, M/s AIASL requested the Authority to approve the prevailing tariff rates for ground handling services at aforesaid airports as an ad-hoc tariff for the period up to 31.03.2026.

3. The tariff determination exercise in respect of Independent Service Providers at Sl. No. 1 & Sl. No. 22 in the above table is currently under progress and MYTPs from the remaining ISPs are yet to be received. Hence, it will take some time for the determination of regular tariffs for the ISPs mentioned in the above tables. Meanwhile, as an interim measure, the Authority decides that the Independent Service Providers, as per the above table, may be allowed to continue to levy the prevailing tariffs (applicable as on 30.09.2025), for a period of six (06) months, w.e.f. 01.10.2025 to 31.03.2026, or, till the determination of regular Tariffs for the aforesaid service providers, whichever is earlier.

4. ISPs who are yet to submit their MYTPs shall take necessary action to submit the same to AERA for determination of regular tariffs.

ORDER

In view of the above, the Authority, in exercise of powers conferred under the Section 13(1)(a) of the Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India Act, 2008, hereby orders that: -

- (i) The **Independent Service Providers** providing services relating to Cargo Facility/ Ground Handling/ Supply of Fuel to the Aircraft at the various Major Airports as per the above Table are allowed to levy the existing tariffs (applicable as on 30.09.2025), for a period of six (06) months effective from **01.10.2025 to 31.03.2026**, or, till the determination of regular tariffs for the abovementioned ISPs, whichever is earlier.
- (ii) The Airport Operators to ensure timely submission of MYTPs by the concerned Independent Service Providers operating at their respective major airports.
